



Established for high-performing students who demonstrate a commitment to excellence in pursuit of a master's degree in business administration at Westcliff.

Scholarship Criteria:

- · Awarded 3 times per year (prior to each semester)
- · Eligibility open to new and continuing students
- . Minimum 3.5 GPA from a qualifying degree (or credits completed)
- . Award amount up to \$5,000 distributed over one year with continuous enrollment
- · Multiple awards may be given
- . Maintaining eligibility for the year requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25
